The Stewards, having received a report from the competitor's representative of car 90, and having summoned the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 69 / Christophe Hamon

Competitor: Team Fullmotorsport

Time (fact): 14:30 hrs

Session: Race 2

Fact: The driver of car 69 made gestures to the driver of car 90 on the slowing down lap and then hit the driver's car in Parc Fermé.

Offence: Alleged breach of Article 15.1 of the GT4 Sporting Regulations.

Decision: **500 Euro fine plus 1 BWP.**

Reason: Whilst conducting the inquiry regarding the incident between cars 69 and 90, it was brought to the attention of the Stewards by the team of car 90 that the driver of car 69 had acted in a provocative manner in the paddock after the race. After the inquiry, the Stewards reviewed video footage and summoned the competitor's representative and driver of car 69 to return. The competitor's representative attended the inquiry however the driver had left the circuit. The Stewards viewed the on-board video from car 90 which showed that the driver of car 69 had made a rude gesture to car 90 on the slowing down lap and once in the paddock had approached car 90, opened the driver's door and gesticulated strongly to the driver including hitting the driver's seat with his hand. The Stewards found that the driver of car 69 had breached article 15.1 and was guilty of unsporting behaviour. The Stewards ordered that the driver be fined.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
