The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director and having summoned the Competitor's Representatives and Drivers, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver : 11 / Hasan Tansu
Competitor: Borusan Otomotiv Motorsport
Session: Race 1
Fact: Cars 2 and 11 were involved in a collision at turn 9.
Time: 10:25
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the GT4 European Series Sporting Regulations and of Article 2d) App L Ch IV of the FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: Reprimand and 1 BWP

Reason: The Stewards received a report from the Race Director that cars 2 and 11 had been involved in a collision at turn 9, both continued.
The Stewards heard from the competitor's representatives of both teams and the drivers. The driver of car 11 was gaining on car 2 and thought that there was an opportunity to overtake car 2 entering turn 9. Car 11 moved to the inside (right) of car 2 but at that moment car 2 moved to enter the corner. Contact was made with the front left corner of car 11 hitting the right rear corner of car 2. The Stewards noted that the driver of car 2 had only checked in his mirror some metres previously and had not been fully aware of the close proximity of car 11 when he entered the corner. The Stewards determined that car 11 was predominantly responsible for the contact but that a limited amount of responsibility remained with the driver of car 2. The Stewards therefore took this into consideration and issued the decision noted above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
